Prior to Installation:

- Make sure you have all necessary parts by checking the diagram and parts list. If any part is missing or damaged, please contact Kraus® Customer Service at 800-775-0703 for a replacement.
- Read all instructions and safety warnings and ensure you have all tools, parts, and equipment necessary for a safe installation.
- Turn off the hot and cold water supply at the angle stops and turn on the old faucet to release any built up pressure. Remove existing faucet. Clean sink or countertop to remove any debris, plumber's putty, or silicone.
- Flush angle stops to release any debris prior to installation.
- Pre-drilled hole size requirement: 1 3/8" (min)
- Max countertop thickness: 2"

Care & Maintenance

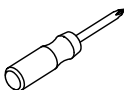
- * To keep the product clean & shining, follow the steps below:

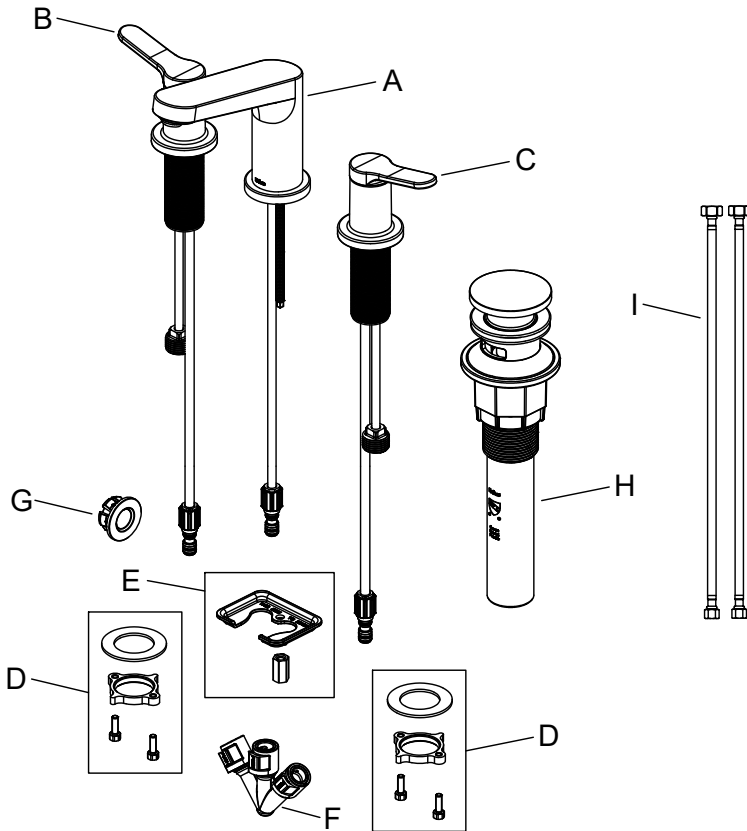

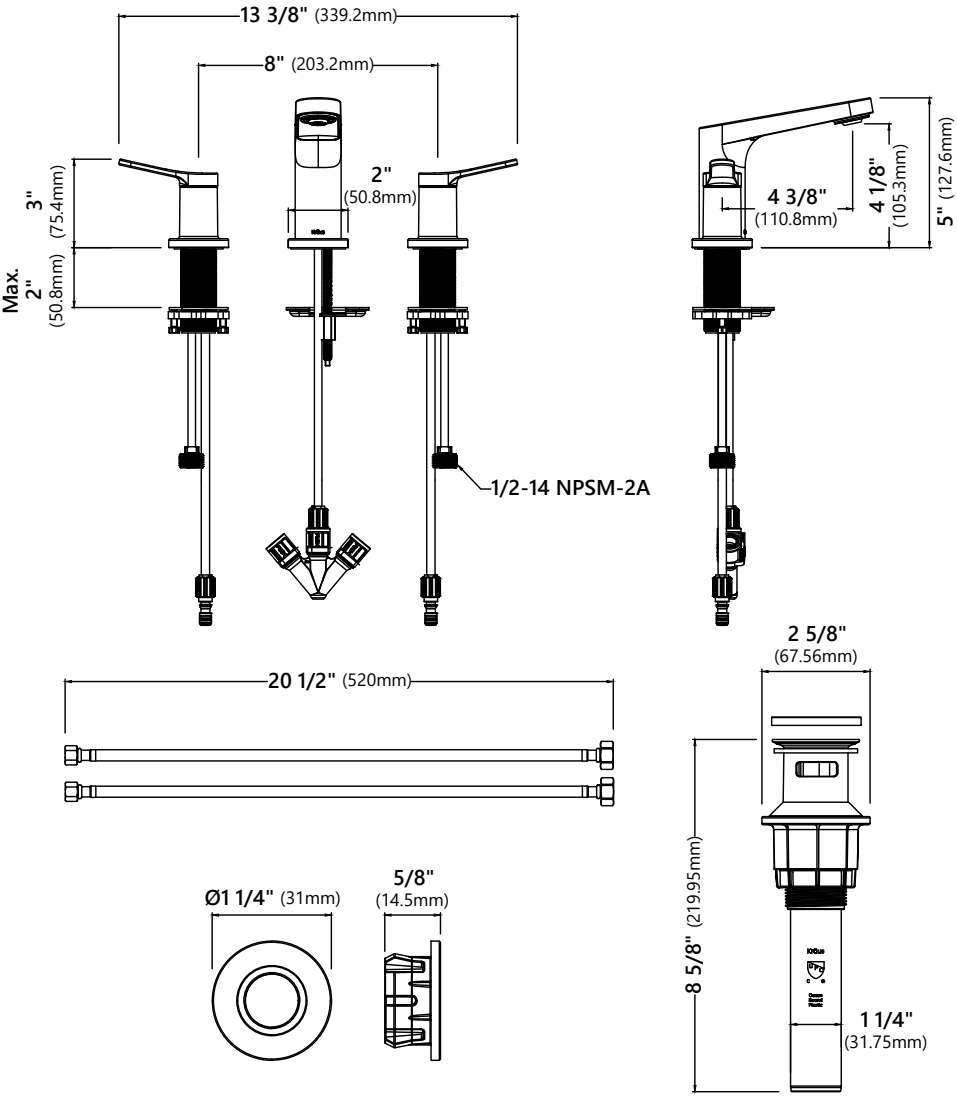

Faucet Dimensions

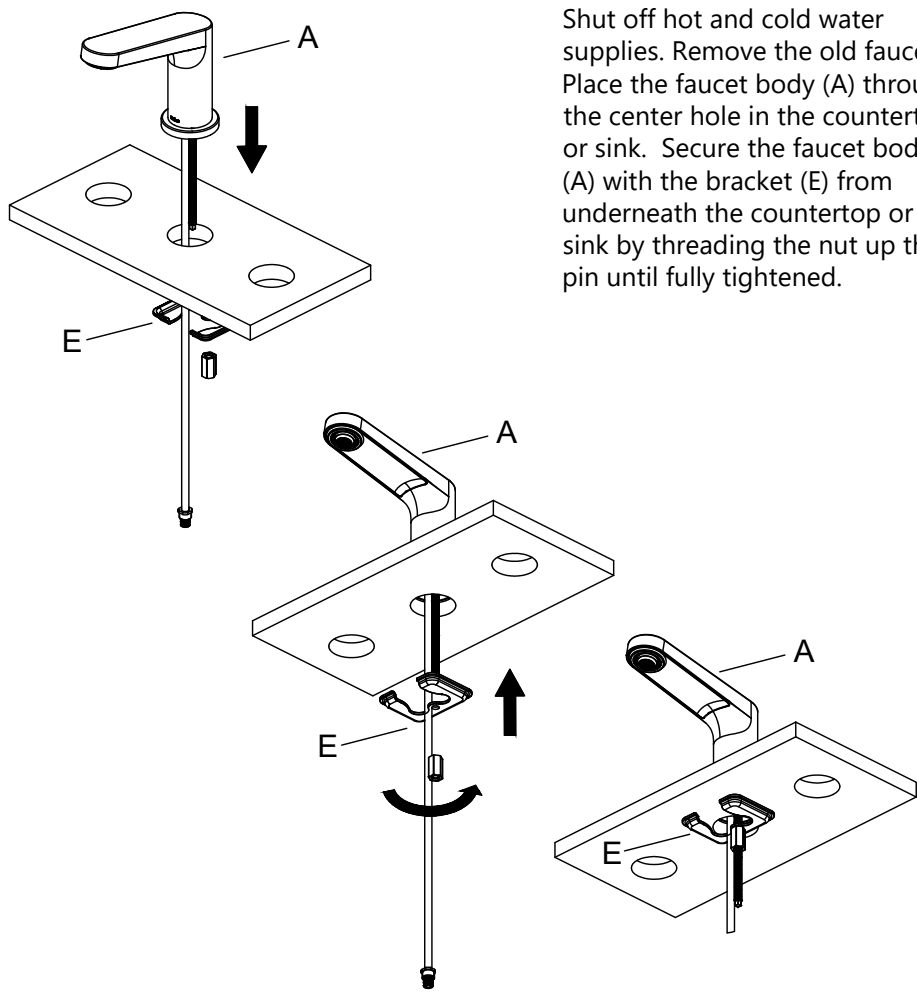


Installer Tip:

Shut off main water supply before installing new faucet.

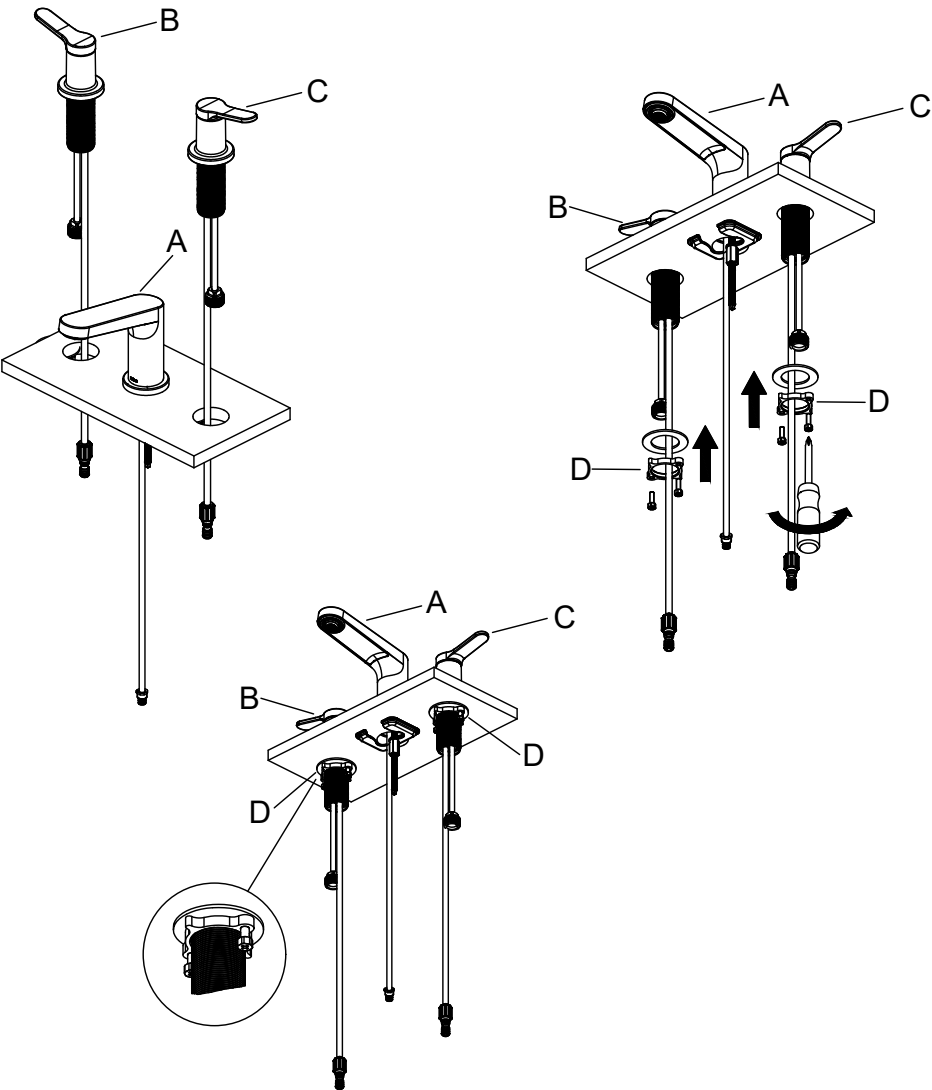
Step 1. Install faucet and mounting bracket

Shut off hot and cold water supplies. Remove the old faucet. Place the faucet body (A) through the center hole in the countertop or sink. Secure the faucet body (A) with the bracket (E) from underneath the countertop or sink by threading the nut up the pin until fully tightened.



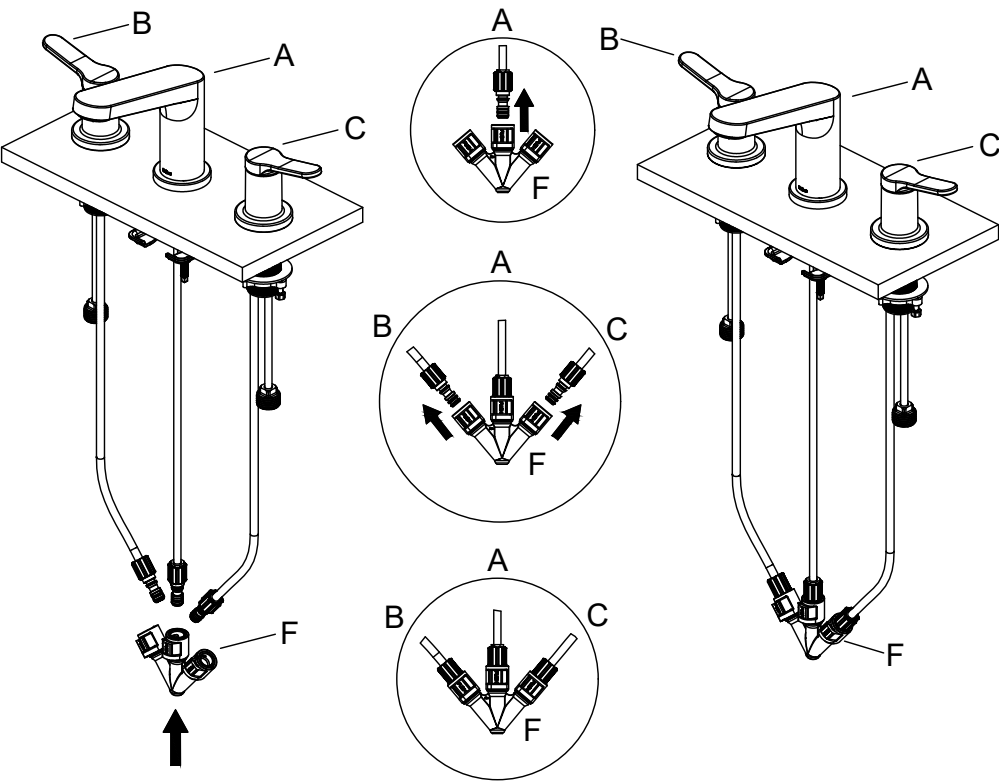
Step 2. Install the handles

Install the hot handle (B) through the left hole in the sink or countertop and secure it with the mounting hardware (D). Place the washer first, then the mounting nut. Secure with the mounting screws using a phillips head screwdriver. Repeat these steps for the cold handle (C) on the right side.

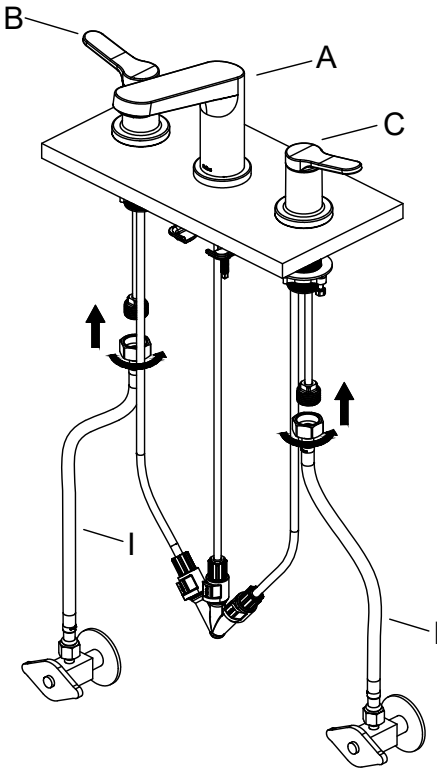


Step 3. Install the three-way connector

Install the three-way connector (F) to the faucet body (A) hose and hot and cold handle (B & C) hoses by pushing up on each.



Step 4. Connect waterlines



Attach waterlines (I) to the faucet. Then attach waterlines to angle stops, matching cold to cold and hot to hot. Tighten all connections until snug. Turn on angle stops and check for leaks. **(DO NOT TURN FAUCET ON)**

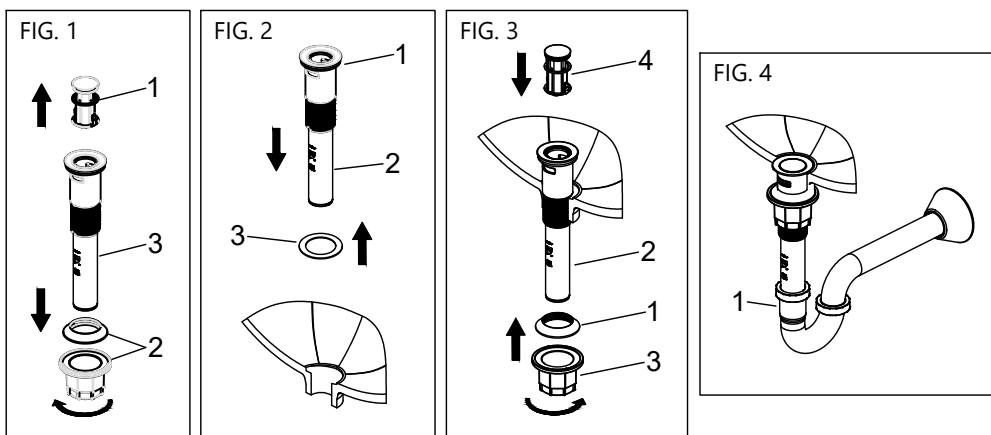
NOTE: Make sure filter washers are installed.

Step 5. Install pop-up drain

Remove head (1), nut, washer and black seal (2) from the body (3). [FIG. 1]

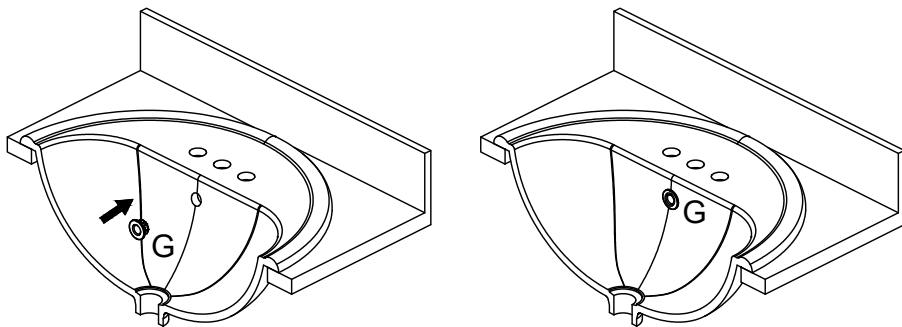
Apply the rubber washer (3) to the underside of the flange (1). Then, insert the body (2) into the sink. [FIG. 2]

Install the black seal (1) onto the threads on the body (2). Install the nut (3) and hand tighten to the sink. Insert the head (4) into the body (2). [FIG. 3] Connect assembly to drain (1). [FIG. 4]

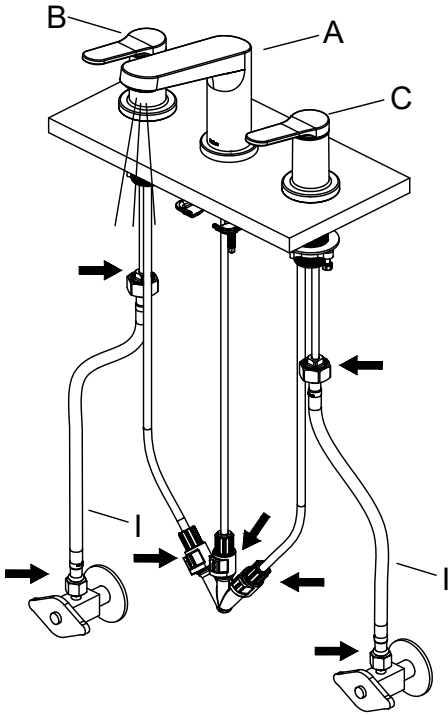


Step 6. Install the overflow cap

Place the overflow cap (G) into the hole in the sink by pushing it in until flush with the sink.

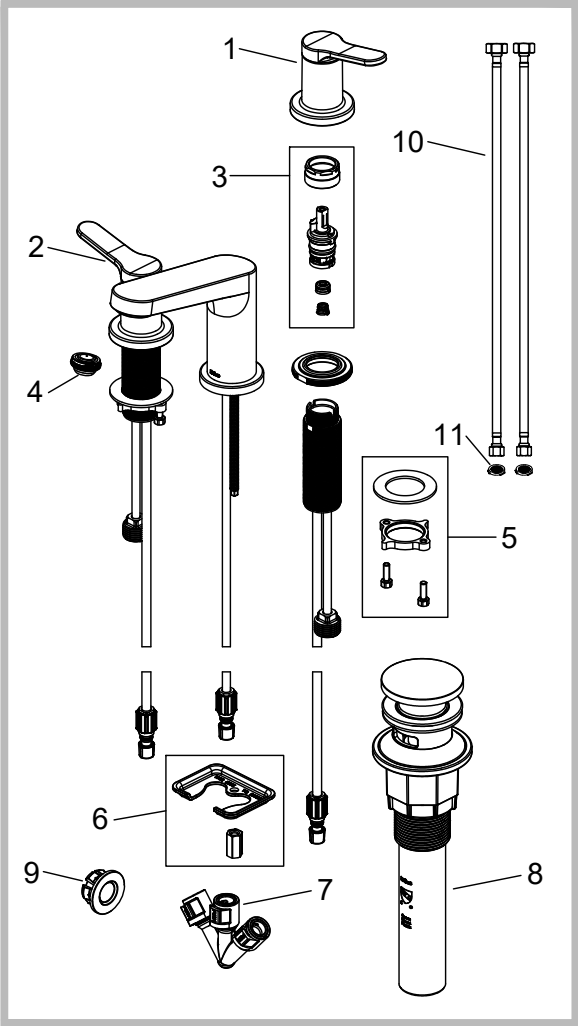


Step 7. Check for leaks/Flush faucet



Turn on the hot and cold water supplies. Turn the water on for 1 minute to remove any debris. Check all connections for leaks. Retighten if necessary, but do not overtighten.

Troubleshooting

If you have followed the instructions carefully and your faucet still does not work properly, take the following corrective steps:

PROBLEM	CAUSE	ACTION
Leakage under faucet handle	Hot or cold cartridge may be loose.	Remove the handle by hand by turning the handle base counterclockwise. Tighten the bonnet nut with an adjustable wrench.
Water does not shut off completely	Cartridge may need to be adjusted or replaced.	Remove the handle by hand by turning the handle base counterclockwise. Loosen bonnet nut with an adjustable wrench. Remove the cartridge. Check for cracks.
Aerator drips or has inconsistent water flow pattern	Aerator is dirty or not seated properly.	Unscrew aerator with aerator wrench and clean out debris.
There is leaking from the sink drain at the base of the sink	The sink has a rough or irregular surface.	Apply additional silicone sealant to the beveled side of the drain flange. Retighten and test for leaks.
There is a low flow of water	The screen filters in the hose connectors are dirty.	Turn off the water supply at the water valves and unscrew the hose connectors from the water supply lines. Clean the screens in the water lines with hot water, removing any debris or calcium build up.

Faucet - Lifetime Limited Warranty

Kraus® USA Plumbing, LLC ("Kraus") extends this warranty to the original purchaser for personal household use of the Faucet when purchased from an authorized Kraus dealer and in the location of original installation. This warranty is non-transferable.

Kraus warrants the structure and finish of the Faucet to be free from defects in material and workmanship under normal usage for as long as the original purchaser resides in the residence in which the Faucet was first installed.

Kraus warrants the Faucet's sprayhead assembly (including the engine, aerators, structure, restrictors, back flow preventers, sprayer hoses, braided supply line hoses which encompasses nylon, silicon and stainless steel) of the product to be free from defects in material and workmanship under normal usage for a period of one (1) year from the date of purchase.

Kraus warrants the Faucet's cartridge to be free from defects in material and workmanship under normal usage for a period of five (5) years from the date of purchase.

Any product reported to the authorized dealer or to Kraus as being defective within the warranty period will be repaired or replaced with a product of equal value at the option of Kraus.

Commercial Warranty

Kraus USA Plumbing, LLC ("Kraus") warrants its Products for a period of one (1) year to commercial purchasers of Products used in industrial, commercial and business applications.

Care and Cleaning Instructions

Certain cleaning products may cause damage to a Product's finish and use of the following on the Product will void this warranty:

- Abrasive cleaners such as powders, bleach, ammonia, alcohol or chlorine
- Abrasive pads, steel wool or wire brushes

What is Not Covered
